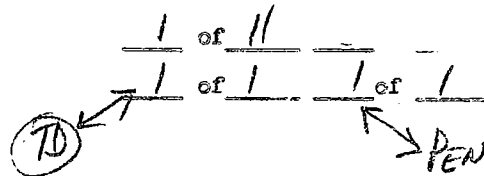

Coach Clive Rush said "Kansas City was just too big and strong today."

As for ~~Kapp~~ Joe Kapp, Rush said "for his first game with us He did well. We're trying to feed him slowly as possible on our system."

Rush said he changed quarterbacks "because of a general lack of offense.

"I'm used to an explosive offense," he went on. "One of our teams once scored 30 points in a minute and 40 seconds."

About Mike Livingston, the Boston coach observed that "the young quarterback did a fine job."

Rush said the early penalty for roughing the kicker was significant, but was not the turning point of the game.

Kapp said "it feels terrible to lose. I just don't like to lose, what more can I tell you."

As for the Chiefs he said "they were just too tough."

Kapp said his game plan had no set pattern, just whatever worked.

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CHIEFS DRESSING ROOM:

Coach Hank Stram: "We entered the game with a twofold purpose-- to hit and execute. I thought we did a fantastic job in both areas. Mike Livingston did a great job in handling the offense. He demonstrated tremendous patience and stayed with the things that were going well."

Stram indicated the fact that Aaron Brown and Buck Buchanan were healthier for this game was directly accountable for the defensive improvement.

On Boston: "They are a fine, tough football team, capable of beating anyone any time they play. The addition of Joe Kapp should definitely give them a boost. However, I think Mike ~~Talix~~ Taliaferro is definitely underrated. Both will solidify their quarterback position."

In summing up, Stram added that Jerrel Wilson's punting was fantastic (5614 average, long of 63). And over all it was another great team effort.
